

Premier Skills English – 2018 World Cup Prediction Competition: Terms and Conditions

The Premier Skills English 2018 World Cup Prediction Competition is subject to the following terms and conditions. By entering this competition entrants are deemed to accept these terms and conditions.

- The Premier Skills English Podcast 2018 World Cup Prediction Competition is open to all
 football fans, other than employees of the British Council and the Premier League, and their
 relatives, family, or household members. The Competition Organiser reserves the right to
 require proof of eligibility.
- 2. An Entry is a submitted webform on one or more of the 2018 World Cup Prediction Competition pages.
- 3. Only registered users will be able to enter the competition and each user will only be able to complete each form once.
- 4. Entries must be submitted online using the webforms on the 2018 World Cup Prediction Competition pages.
- 5. Webforms must be posted before the 2018 World Cup Prediction Competition closes. Match predictions can only be made before the matches start. The form fields will be removed as the matches are played.
- 6. The Premier Skills English 2018 World Cup Prediction Competition will close at 1600 (BST) on the 15th July 2018.
- 7. Results will not be published until Monday 16th July.
- 8. The British Council will not accept responsibility for any entries that are corrupt, damaged, lost or inaccessible.
- 9. At the discretion of the Competition Organiser, defamatory or illegal entries will be deleted.
- 10. Users will score one point for predicting the correct result (the winner or a draw) and three points for predicting the correct scores.
- 11. At the end of the competition, the top 5 highest scoring users will be declared winners. In the event of tied scores, winners will be selected at random from the tied scoring entries.
- 12. Winners will be notified by email at the address associated with the entrant's account on Premier Skills English.
- 13. If the winner has not opted to be contactable by email, their entry will be excluded from the prizes.
- 14. Winners will be required to respond to the notification email within 2 days of the message being sent. If a winner fails to respond within 2 days, they will no longer be deemed a winner and will lose any claim to the prize.
- 15. Winners will be required to provide a valid address for the prize to be delivered.
- 16. The prize for the Premier Skills English 2018 World Cup Prediction Competition is a Premier League football shirt from a Premier League team of the winner's choice.
- 17. The prize will be delivered using an international delivery company.
- 18. The Competition Organisers will not accept responsibility for any failure to deliver a prize, either because the address provided by the winner is incomplete or because the company cannot legally operate in the winner's country.
