Stoppages:

goal kick

Example: A goal kick is given when an attacker sends the ball out of play over the goal line. The goal kick is taken inside the six yard box.

spot.

A **sending-off** is when the referee shows a player a red card. He has to leave the field of

Example: A **substitution** is when one player replaces

another on the pitch. In most matches, teams

can make three substitutions.

Stoppages:

throw-in

Example: A **throw-in** is given when the ball goes out of play over the touchline A player throws the ball

onto the pitch from behind the touchline.

Example: An injury is when a player is hurt and needs

medical attention. Play stops while the physio

attends to the injury.

booking

Example: A **booking** is when a player is cautioned. The

referee writes the player's name in his

notebook.

Stoppages:

corner kick

Example: A corner kick (often simply 'corner') is given when the defending team sends the ball over the goal line. The **corner** is taken from the

corner flag.

Example: A free kick is used to restart play. It can be

direct or indirect.
