

1. Vocabulary: English  
More Club: ball boy

Example: The **ball boy** collects the ball when it goes out of play and throws it back to the players.



2. Vocabulary: English  
More Club: division

Example: In professional football, there are lots of different leagues for teams at different levels. Each of these league levels is a **division**. The Premier League is the top **division**.



3. Vocabulary: English  
More Club: first-team

Example: The **first-team** is the eleven players from a club that the manager selects to start a match.



4. Vocabulary: English  
More Club: mascot

Example: Football clubs often have animals or toys for **mascots** which they take to their matches to bring them luck. Often, someone dresses up as the club **mascot** to encourage the crowd.



5. Vocabulary: English  
More Club: medics

Example: The **medics** are the medical professionals who help injured players at a football match.



6. Vocabulary: English  
More Club: nickname

Example: A club's **nickname** is an unofficial name used by fans and people familiar with the club.



7. Vocabulary: English  
More Club: reserves

Example: **Reserves** are players who don't make it into the first team. They are the players that the manager can use if a player is injured.



8. Vocabulary: English  
More Club: sponsor

Example: A **sponsor** is a business or organisation that give a club money to have their logo on the club's shirt.



9. Vocabulary: English  
More Club: transfer

Example: When a player **transfers** to a new club, they move to that club. Sometimes, there are **transfer** fees worth millions of pounds.



10. Vocabulary: English  
More Club: trophy

Example: The **trophy** is the cup that a team is presented with when they win a competition.
