Entertainment / Restaurants / Cafes	Luna Park in St Kilda, the Rivoli Cinema, Melbourne Theatre Company (MTC), the Docklands, Little Italy and more.
Shopping	Bourke Street Mall, Queen Victoria Market, and Chadstone, or more English language learning activities
Education	St. Michael's Grammar School (from kindergarten – secondary school)
	Universities: Melbourne University, La Trobe University, Monash University
Top tip	Go to the top of Rialto Tower skyscraper for the best view of Melbourne.




