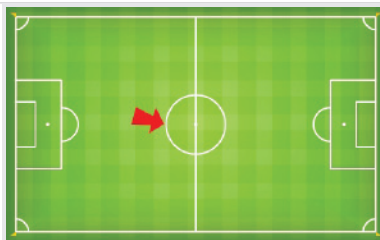


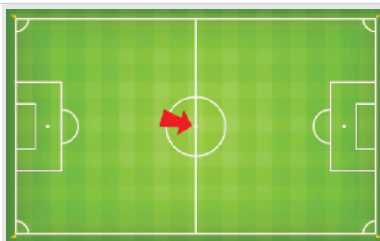
1. **Vocabulary:** English
The pitch: **centre circle**

Example: The **centre circle** is a large circle around the centre spot. For the kick-off the opposing players must not enter the **centre circle**.



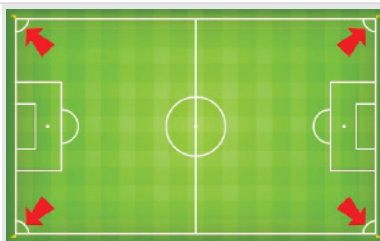
2. **Vocabulary:** English
The pitch: **centre spot**

Example: The **centre spot** is a small circle in the middle of the pitch. The ball is put on the **centre spot** at the start of the game.



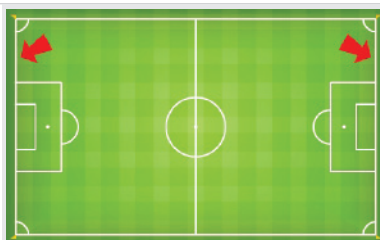
3. **Vocabulary:** English
The pitch: **corners**

Example: In each of the four **corners** of the pitch, there is a small semi-circle with a flag. You take corner kicks from this semi-circle.



4. **Vocabulary:** English
The pitch: **goal lines**

Example: The **goal lines** go along the two ends of the pitch.



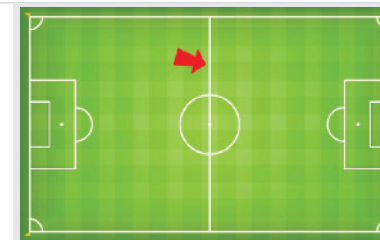
5. **Vocabulary:** English
The pitch: **goal**

Example: The part of the pitch where the ball must go for the team to score. The **goal** has two posts, a crossbar and a net.



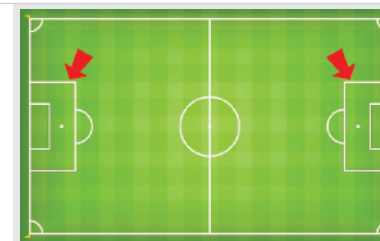
6. **Vocabulary:** English
The pitch: **halfway line**

Example: The **halfway line** goes across the middle of the pitch.



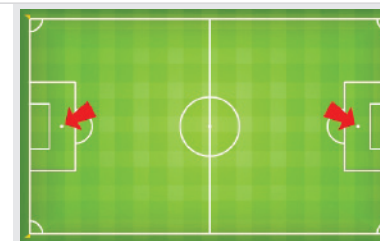
7. **Vocabulary:** English
The pitch: **penalty area**

Example: The **penalty area** is a large rectangular zone in front of the goal. The goalkeeper can't use his hands outside the area.



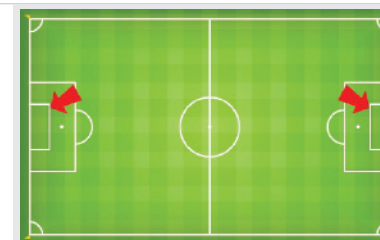
8. **Vocabulary:** English
The pitch: **penalty spot**

Example: The **penalty spot** is a small circle inside the penalty area. You take penalties from the **penalty spot**.



9. **Vocabulary:** English
The pitch: **six yard box**

Example: The **six yard box** (or "goal area") is a small rectangular zone in front of the goal. You take goal kicks from inside the box.



10. **Vocabulary:** English
The pitch: **touch lines**

Example: The **touch lines** go along the two sides of the pitch.
